

Bird List of Maquipucuna Reserve and Bosque Protector Cuenca Alta del Río Guayllabamba. 2010.

The list below tries to cover all the birds in the whole area of Maquipucuna Reserve (6000 hectares aprox) in a range of 900 masl. to 2800 masl. The letter: **L** means Lodge, the birds marked with a symbol: **⊖**, refer the birds seen in the Lodge Area (from 1300 masl. to 1800 masl. aprox / from 4265,09 feet to 5905,51 feet) but not their status, the fluctuation of them it's from Common to Rare. **B:** Boreal Migrant. **CHO:** Chocó and **NCA:** Northern Central Andes (Birds Restricted to both Endemic Bird Areas). IUCN Global Red List: **NT:** Near Threatened, **VU:** Vulnerable.

The species names are based on SACC (South American Classification Committee); english names between parentheses are the names referred by Ridgely and Greenfield in the Ecuadorian Field Guides (versions 2001 & 2006). The english names are placed in alphabetic order trying to be helpful with a quick searching; the family groups are placed in evolutionary order.
